To qualify for prize/prize money, a competitor must qualify in the top twenty point scorers in the Championship series or the top ten point scorers of the Development series, and also must attend the Annual Dinner presentation night to receive their prize.

Failure to attend the dinner will result in the forfeit of all prizes/prize monies. If a competitor is unable to attend, a family member or team member of that competitor may accept their award.(a member from another team cannot accept the award)

If, for example, a competitor finishes tenth, and fails to attend the dinner, competitors placed after tenth will move up one spot. This means if the competitor who finished 21st is present at the dinner, that competitor will move into the top twenty and will receive prize money. There are no restrictions or minimum requirements as to how many events a competitor must attend to qualify.

Attendance points for a normal meeting will be 50 points.
Attendance points for double point's rounds (as nominated by the committee) will be 100 points.

Of the 18 rounds in division 1, a driver's best 16 rounds will be counted towards series points.

eg. If a driver contests 18 rounds, only his/her best 16 rounds will be counted. If a driver contests 16 or less rounds, all of his/her rounds will be counted.

Of the 9 rounds in division 2, all rounds will be counted towards series points.

If a car has completed half the race distance in a feature and pulls to infield, it is not necessary to cross finish line for points and prize money.

The car will be allocated a finishing position based on how many laps completed. Points and prize money will be paid accordingly.

A black flag or less than half race distance completed in feature will result in DNF.
