Annual General Meeting

The Annual General Meeting of the Super Sedan Association Inc. will be conducted at 2.30pm on Saturday, July 16 2005 at Ian Boettcher Motors, 1 Brisbane Rd, Bundamba.

All members are encouraged to attend and have a say in the future direction of your organisation, take part in the election of office bearers and raise any issues and suggestions for discussion and/or consideration. Observers and guests are welcome to attend, however only financial members of the Super Sedan Association can take part in official ballots.

The following Management Committee positions are to be filled by a ballot of members at the Annual General Meeting: **President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer and Drivers Representatives (x3)**. Anybody wanting to nominate for a position on the Management Committee must submit a written nomination no later than 7 days prior to the Annual General Meeting. Nominations will only be accepted from the floor if no written nominations have been received. Only a financial member of the Super Sedan Association is eligible to nominate for a position. The written nomination must be endorsed by another financial member of the Super Sedan Association. A nomination form is attached.

Those members unable to attend may appoint a proxy to act on their behalf in all official ballots. The proxy must be a financial member of the Super Sedan Association and must have written permission to vote on behalf of another member. A proxy form is attached.

Amendment to Supplementary Regulations

All Super Sedan Association members are hereby advised that, following a ballot of members at a General Meeting of the Association, conducted at Charlton Raceway on Sunday, March 27, the Association has amended the Supplementary Regulations of the 2004/2005 Aussie Trackwear Super Sedan Championship Series and the 2004/2005 Russ Equipment Super Sedan Series. **Supplementary Regulation #8** has been amended to read as follows:

Any driver who nominates for competition and fails to appear without having cancelled his/her nomination in accordance with the published procedures and timeframes, will not be eligible for the \$100 appearance guarantee at their next event, will start rear of field during all qualifying heats at their next event and will be penalised 100 points.

It is the responsibility of each competitor to be aware of the correct procedures and deadlines for the submission and/or cancellation of nominations. Furthermore, it is the responsibility of competitors to be aware of all SSA policy, procedures, rules and regulations.

Drivers Briefing

All competitors are also hereby advised of a change in the procedures for Drivers Briefing. At the commencement of each Drivers Briefing, a roll call will be taken to confirm the attendance of competitors. Once the roll call is completed, the grid draws for the qualifying heats will take place and only those drivers in attendance during roll call will be permitted to take part in the grid draws. Drivers only will be permitted to take part in the grid draws (crew members or other representatives are not acceptable) and any driver who is absent during roll call (regardless of the reason) will be subject to the penalties prescribed in **Supplementary Regulation #7**, which reads:

Any driver who fails to attend the Drivers Briefing is not eligible for attendance points and will start rear of field in all of their qualifying heats.

All competitors must be at the circuit by 4.45pm, with the Drivers Briefing to be held no earlier than 5.00pm.

Payment of Fines

All SSA competitors are hereby advised that all fines and/or monetary penalties incurred as a result of a breach of any SSA Supplementary Regulation will be deducted from prizemoney. The amounts will be deducted from prizemoney earned at the race meeting in which the breach occurred, or the race meeting/s immediately following the issuing of a penalty notice until the full amount has been paid. Fines and penalties incurred as a result of a breach of the SSA Supplementary Regulations are not subject to appeal.
